Flora

Clean terracotta and natural stone floors with a concentrated neutral cleaner that removes dirt, protects wax treatments and leaves no dull



Technical data:

- Physical state: blue liquid
- Specific gravity (g/cm³): 1
- pH: 7-8

Description:

Concentrated neutral floor cleaner for the routine cleaning of wax-treated and untreated terracotta, natural stone and cement-based agglomerate floors. Effectively cleans and degreases without damaging the surface or leaving dull streaks.

Fields of application:

Suitable for the routine cleaning of:

- treated and untreated terracotta floors;
- natural stone;
- cement-based agglomerates;
- wax-treated surfaces.

Characteristics:

FLORA is a concentrated neutral cleaner specifically developed for the routine cleaning of terracotta, natural stone and cement-based agglomerate floors, whether wax-treated or untreated. In particular, it:

- effectively cleans and degreases without damaging stone surfaces or wax treatments;
- is ideal for the routine maintenance of terracotta, natural stone and cement-based agglomerate floors and surfaces;
- cleans without leaving dull streaks and leaves a pleasant lavender fragrance;
- features a low-foam formula suitable for use with scrubber dryers.

Instructions for use:

Daily cleaning

- Dilute 10–20 ml of FLORA in 5 litres of water.
- Apply the solution with a soft microfibre cloth as you would with a regular floor cleaner.
- At this dilution, FLORA is also suitable for use with scrubber dryers.

Routine cleaning

- Dilute 30–50 ml of FLORA in 5 litres of water.
- Apply the solution with a soft microfibre cloth as you would with a regular floor cleaner.

Intensive cleaning

- Dilute 250–500 ml of FLORA in 1 litre of water.
- Recommended for deep degreasing of untreated floors and for removing the build-up of dirty or deteriorated maintenance wax from treated floors.
- Apply the solution with a soft microfibre cloth.
- Leave it to work for a few minutes.
- Scrub the surface with a red buffer pad or a red disc.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water.

Yield:

Coverage is approximate and depends on the absorbency of the surface, the level of soiling and the selected dilution.

- Daily cleaning: up to 2,000–4,000 m² with 1 litre of product.
- Routine cleaning: up to 800–1,500 m² with 1 litre of product.
- Intensive cleaning: approximately 50–100 m² with 1 litre of product.
